Shelter Stats Collector

About the job: Volunteers needed to call all 67 counties in the state of Florida and gather annual statistics from their government contracted/run shelters. Florida statute 823.15 outlines all the data they must provide on a monthly basis. If they only have the 12 months, this is fine but the annual totals need to be put together. You will want to gain positive relationships and have a contact each year for the fastest results. There is a spreadsheet for reference (phone numbers/locations) and a Google Drive folder for putting the documents into. Once all the data is gathered, volunteers complete a simple spreadsheet to show intake, euthanasia, and population (based on most recent census).

Best people for the job: Persistent, well-spoken, tactful

Age requirements: 16 & up

Time involved: Project can take up to 4 months to complete. This is all based on how quickly the information is obtained.

Minimum requirements: Must have a phone, email, understand how to use spreadsheets, and be able to save to the Google Drive. Spreadsheets can be handwritten and Google Drive can be taught.
